Expectations

We have three strands based on the needs of our children. We ask for parents to:

- Read with their children at least three times a week for ten minutes. This is recorded in their reading record book and children who read regularly will be rewarded with 'Golden Tickets' which provides them with an opportunity to win books.
- Practise the times tables in line with the guidance from our times tables document which will be sent home and can be found on our website.
- Newsletters in the form of Knowledge Organisers are sent home to parents/carers in order class-based work to be supported at home
