

# Year 3: Traditional Tales

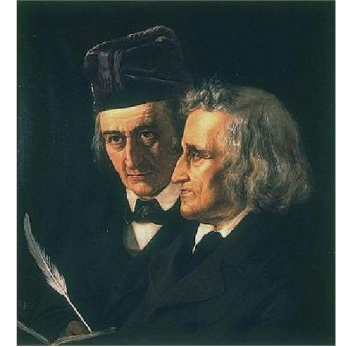
## We will think deeply about:

## Key knowledge:

### Brothers Grimm:

- German brothers, Jakob and Wilhelm Grimm.
- Famous for their collection of folktales and fairy tales, for example 'Little Red Riding Hood' and 'Hansel and Gretel'.
- They lived between 1785 and 1863.



## Key vocabulary:

- **Traditional** – something that is long-established and passed down.
- **Originated** – where something began.
- **Tale** – a fictitious or true story that is imaginatively recounted.
- **Era** – a period of history.
- **Recounted** – to tell someone about an event or experience.

- Find out about the original stories written by the Brothers Grimm.
