

# Year 3 Vicious Vikings

## We will think deeply about:

- Secure understanding of the countries in Europe surrounding the UK.
- Why the Vikings invaded the UK.
- The impact of the Viking invasions on the people living in Britain at the time.
- How Norwich changed as a settlement over time from the Anglo-Saxon period

## Key vocabulary:

- Homeland – a person's or people's native land.
- Settlement – a place, typically one which has previously been uninhabited, where people establish a community.
- Invasion – an instance of invading a country or region with an armed force.
- Kingdom - a country, state, or territory ruled by a king or queen.
- Anglo-Saxons – the inhabitants of England from their arrival in the 5th century up to the Norman Conquest.
